Spring 2022 Luncheon Speaker: Frank R. Jimenez



Frank R. Jimenez is Group Vice President and General Counsel of GE Healthcare, a leading global medical technology, pharmaceutical diagnostics, and digital solutions innovator. Based in Chicago, IL, Frank is responsible for all legal, government affairs, and compliance matters, including litigation, intellectual property and licensing, international trade compliance, labor & employment, data privacy, environmental, M&A, corporate governance, and business risk. Previously, Frank served as Executive Vice President and General Counsel of Raytheon Technologies Corporation, a leader in technologies across the full spectrum of aviation, space and defense formed by the 2020 merger of Raytheon Company and United Technologies Corporation.

In prior corporate positions, Frank served as General Counsel for Raytheon Company (defense), Bunge Limited (agribusiness and food), Xylem Inc. (fluid technology), and ITT Corporation (multi-industrial), where he managed the 2011 spin-offs of two public companies, Xylem and Exelis Inc. (defense technology). In prior public service, Frank served as the 21st General Counsel of the

Navy, one of seven Senate-confirmed Pentagon civilians of four-star equivalent rank overseeing the U.S. Navy and Marine Corps; Deputy General Counsel (Legal Counsel) of the U.S. Department of Defense; Principal Deputy General Counsel of the Navy; Chief of Staff at the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development; and Deputy Chief of Staff and Acting General Counsel for Florida Governor Jeb Bush. Previously, he was a litigation partner at Steel Hector & Davis (now Squire Patton Boggs) in Miami, FL, and clerked for Judge Pamela Ann Rymer of the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit in Pasadena, CA.

Frank graduated from the University of Miami and the Yale Law School, where he was an editor of the Yale Law Journal and recipient of the Harlan Fiske Stone and Benjamin N. Cardozo moot court prizes for best oral argument and brief. He also holds an M.B.A. from the University of Pennsylvania's Wharton School and an M.A. from the U.S. Naval War College. He serves on the boards of HII (Huntington Ingalls Industries), Equal Justice Works, and the Yale Law School Fund, and the advisory boards of the Columbia University Mailman School of Public Health, the Yale Law School Center for the Study of Corporate Law, the University of Miami Herbert Business School, and the National Security Institute of the Antonin Scalia Law School at George Mason University.

In Memoriam

The Tribe wishes to acknowledge, recognize, honor and celebrate our fellow Iron Arrows whom we have been notified passed on since the last newsletter. Our Tribe and the University of Miami community mourn their passing. We reach out together as a Tribe to support their families and reflect on their amazing legacies. They will be forever missed, forever Miami Hurricanes and forever Iron Arrows. Please visit the Iron Arrow website's "News" section for additional information on these remarkable members. Members are listed in order of passing from most recent to most distant.

Dr. William R. Butler (1926-2021) - Served as the University of Miami's first vice president for student affairs for 32 years, playing a key role in making the University more diverse as it boosted its enrollment of Black and international students. In 1989, founded a center offering students the opportunity to volunteer for service-oriented organizations throughout Miami-Dade County. He helped spearhead the construction of the Herbert Wellness Center, which opened a year before he retired. Served as a professor of education, teaching a course in the University's School of Education and Human Development.

Dr. Jonathan West (1946-2022) - Leader of the University of Miami's Master in Public Administration program for 35 years, beginning his tenure in January 1981. Recipient of the lifetime achievement award from the American Society for Public Administration's Section on Ethics, and Luis Glaser Mentorship Award in 2021.
