Fall 2023 Luncheon Speaker: Dr. Alexis Martinez



We are honored to share that this year's Fall 2023 Luncheon Speaker will be Dr. Alexis Martinez (initiated Fall 2003). Alexis graduated from The U in 2001 with a bachelor's degree in business administration, with a focus on international finance and marketing and went on to earn her J.D. from Miami Law in 2004, followed by a master's degree in Higher Education Administration / Enrollment Management in 2006. After her time at UM, she also completed her Doctor of Education (EdD) in Higher Education Leadership and Policy at Vanderbilt University.

Alexis is currently the Executive Director for Equity and Compliance Programs and Interim Title IX Coordinator for The Georgia Institute of Technology (Georgia Tech). Having just celebrated the 50th anniversary of Title IX legislation in June of 2022, her commitment to equality within educational programs that receive federal funding is a testament to the substantial progress we have made as a society. She is on the Board for the Georgia Latino Law Foundation, as well as Committee on Virtual Programming for the National Association of College and University Attorneys. She previously served on the Executive Committee of the Student Services Section for the Association of American Law Schools.

During her time at UM, Alexis championed the five criteria of our organization as Chief of Iron Arrow for two terms (2004-2006), the only female Chief to have done so. She was one of the youngest Rathskeller Advisory Board Chairs in history, and a founding sister of her sorority, Zeta Tau Alpha. She was also a Mentor at Big Brothers/ Big Sisters of Miami, and Vice President of Selections for the UM Circle of $O\Delta K$. She continued her service and leadership into her graduate career, serving as Treasurer of Miami Law Women, Chair Emeritus for Miami Law Orientation, Co-Advisor of Mortar Board, a HOPE Project Leader, and is a member of the Society of Bar and Gavel Honor Society. As a lifetime member of Omicron Delta Kappa, in 2021 she extended her service from the UM Circle to the national level by Serving as Chair of the 2021 National Leadership Conference and a member of the National Board with fellow IAs, Former Son of Chief, Peter Christiaans and former Chief Cynthia "Cie" Chapel. She was also a featured $O\Delta K$ Member for the organization's 2022 National Hispanic Heritage Month celebrations.





Fittingly, Alexis' Tapping Luncheon speaker was none other than the beloved Audrey Finklestein, who, when asked why she was so committed to her alma mater and

to keeping her fellow Hurricanes committed as well simply replied with seven words: "To know UM is to love UM." To say Alexis has taken those words to heart would be an understatement. When Iron Arrow ceremoniously tapped the UM Mascot, Sebastian The Ibis, and a jacket was needed, Alexis gave up her tapping jacket during her term as Chief, which, to this day, adorns the mascot costume during Homecoming.
